# Rector's Corner

## Do You See It? That Star in the Sky?

I wonder what it was about that star that those Wise Men from the East would come so far to see. Bethlehem was not *too* far from the crossroads of the world at that time, but it wasn't on the way to anyplace really. You still had to go there on purpose, and it wasn't exactly a destination resort.

A supernova or a comet, I am sure, could just as easily have been observed from where they lived. They told Herod they had read of a king's birth in the Hebrew Scriptures, but these were not Jews. They had to have been familiar with scriptural references such as Isaiah. But why? Under more earthly circumstances the Bible would have seemed to be nothing more than the obscure literature of a small powerless people, in a remote Roman province. Hardly the stuff of such a compulsion for a band of magi.

The Magi were widely known and respected for their wisdom and learning. Whether they came down from Chaldea, or even farther from the land of Persia or Medea, this trip was daunting. It was not the sort of trip you take on a whim. It took planning and resources.

Perhaps a clue to their compulsion lies in what the shepherds saw the night that Jesus was born. Scripture tells us they were watching their flocks that night, perhaps also gazing innocently into the night sky, when they were suddenly surrounded by angels, bright light, and singing. It obviously frightened them enough that the angels had to tell them not to be afraid. Where had those angels come from?

A hole in the heavens, perhaps big enough for heaven's own light to pour through? In any case, angels coming and going--- in the clear night sky could be a pretty bright and amazing sight, I think. Perhaps bright enough to be seen from a good distance away--like the East. Might such a thing look like a star of unusual brightness? Perhaps.

But how come more people in town and elsewhere nearer by didn't seem to notice or even care? Herod didn't seem to know that *anything* was unusual until the Magi told him, and Herod lived only a few miles away from the place where it all happened. He was surrounded by advisors, astrologers, etc. who should have seen anything obvious and told him. Yet none of these seemed to notice either, though they should have known right where to look it up!

Is it possible that heaven is somehow not equally visible to *every* eye? What does it take to see the holy when it is in our midst? Is it —somehow—something that must be in the heart that makes the stuff of heaven visible to the eyes of earth?

I think that star still shines, and is there still if we really want to see it. I don't mean that it is a product of wishful thinking ("serious delusions" to those deemed wise these days). I think such visions can still come to the honestly searching heart that is not terminally invested in its sins. I earnestly believe that any heart truly looking for a better way, and is willing to shed death and darkness for life and truth can, I think, see God.

Jesus brought the Kingdom of God into our world with His birth, and it has never left us. Heaven is still with us from that moment. There is only one snag. We have to want it. And we have to want Him. He won't go about meddling in our affairs, or forcing the stuff of heaven upon us.

He won't even force us to see the brilliant Star that is there still. Gleaming in the darkness, never—never---overcome. It has never stopped shining, ever since that cold night when the heavens themselves were split open and the stuff of heaven entered the everyday world of earth.

But sometimes you just have to look, where God has said "where he wills to be found." And as far as I can tell, that place is right here in our midst... overhead in the sky where we live. Do you see it? Come and see!

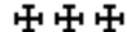

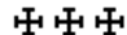

Margaret Markham has successfully completed the long series of medical treatments on both her eyes. Now she can read, sew and generally see fully again.

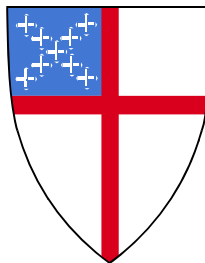

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### Persimmon Orange Bar

1 cup	Thick persimmon pulp (about 2 persimmons)
1 tsp	Soda
1 cup	Brown sugar
½ cup	Margarine
1 ea	Egg, beaten
2 cups	Flour
2 tbsp	Orange juice
2 tsp	Grated orange rind
1 tsp	Cinnamon
½ tsp each	Cloves, nutmeg, salt
1 cup	Shopped nuts
1 cup	Raisins

Sprinkle soda over persimmon pulp in bowl and blend. Add sugar and margarine. Blend until creamy. Add egg. Blend well. Add orange juice and orange rind. Sift flour with spices and salt. Add and blend until smooth. Fold in nuts and raisins. Pour into greased 8" or 9" square pan. Bake at 350° 20 to 25 minutes or until tests done. Cut in bars while warm. Cool in pan. Improves with age.

Note: You can substitute ¼ cup of orange or lemon marmalade.
